Description:

If you are an NDHS student with an interest in history...this is the club for you! The focus of the group is to increase historical knowledge, share & experience local "Eastern Shore" history, and connect to broader themes of historical interpretation. This club organization will focus on having fun with history at the local level and at times go out and visit local historical locations and get "hands on!" Connections with local shore historical groups like the Sultana Projects Inc., Dorchester County Historical Society, Nause-Waiwash Indians & Harriet Tubman Museum, etc., will be made! And skills in cooperation, initiative, leadership, **advocacy**, citizenship & community awareness will be fostered.

Membership Criteria:

For current enrolled North Dorchester High School students. To qualify students must be in in good academic standing. IMP or suspensions will result in forfeit of membership for the remainder of the semester.

Those interested need a brief (1/2page) letter of interest describing why you want to be in the club along with your ideas for the club. It needs to be signed by a teacher/appropriate adult mentor.

Attendance/Meetings:

There is 1 afterschool meeting a month and 2-3 trips during school throughout the year. There may be occasional lunch time activities, history labs or guest speakers during the school day. Members must attend the majority (over half) of the all the afterschool meetings and least 1-2 trips and be willing to assist with club duties during non-academic times of the school day throughout the year.
